

SOTS Winter Meeting, 3rd – 5th January 2023

Travel Information for Endcliffe Village Campus, Sheffield

For general advice on travel, see the Sheffield University website <https://www.sheffield.ac.uk/visitors/maps-travel> . This has comprehensive information and useful links. What follows here is an overview, with some added information relevant to our meeting. This information is accurate at the time of writing but **you are advised to check your route online before departure**. Monday 2nd January 2023 is a Bank Holiday throughout the UK and Tuesday 3rd January is also a Bank Holiday in Scotland.

International Travel to Sheffield (including from Northern Ireland)

If arriving by Eurostar, there are frequent connecting services to Sheffield at the Eurostar terminus station, London St Pancras International. This service is operated by East Midlands Railway, eastmidlandsrailway.co.uk .

If arriving by air, note that at the time of writing **Doncaster/Sheffield airport is due to close permanently at the end of October 2022**. Nearby airports with rail services to Sheffield are Manchester manchesterairport.co.uk (one change at Manchester Piccadilly), and Birmingham International birminghamairport.co.uk (one change at Birmingham New Street). See the university website mentioned above for approximate journey times from these and other arrival points.

Travel from within the UK

For travel by car use satnav codes as follows (with telephone numbers in case of difficulty): for The Edge: S10 3ED, phone 0114 222 2000; for Jonas Hotel S10 3ER, with phone 0114 222 8816; and for Halifax Hall Hotel S10 3ER with phone 0114 222 8810. Details of car parking arrangements, if needed, will be sent to you once you have booked for the meeting.

For public transport by train or coach, there is guidance on the same website, under 'National Public Transport.' Useful detailed websites are nationalrail.co.uk and nationalexpress.com .

Travel to Endcliffe Village Campus from central Sheffield

When researching bus routes or ordering taxis be sure to specify 'Endcliffe Student Village' rather than 'University of Sheffield.'

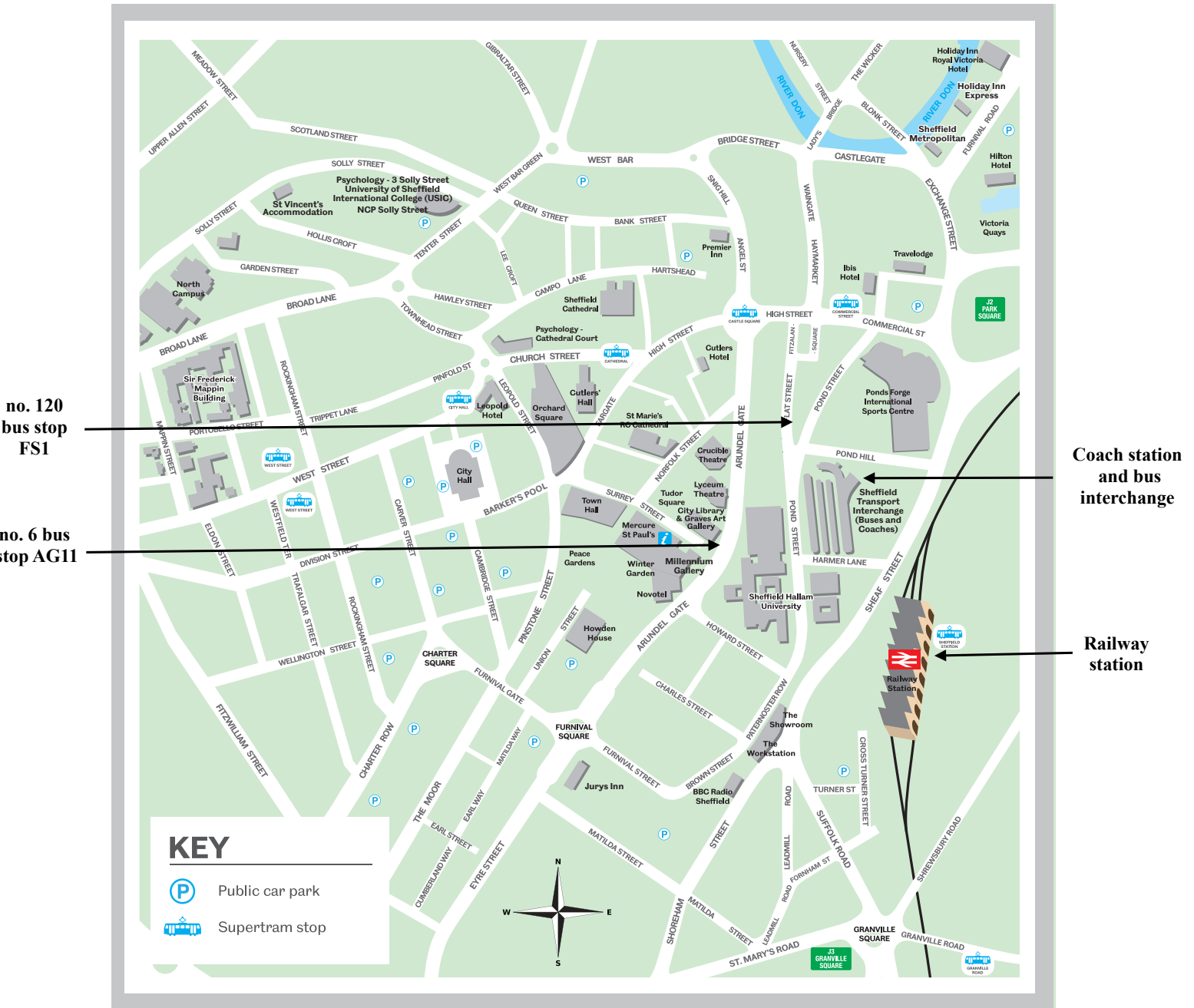
Taxis: there is a licensed taxi rank at Sheffield train station. The journey takes 15-20 minutes. Let the driver know which part of the campus you need: Jonas Hotel or Halifax Hall Hotel if resident, or The Edge if a day delegate. Minicab firms and Uber also operate within Sheffield.

Public transport within Sheffield: see the university website mentioned above, under 'Local Public Transport.' There are several possible bus or tram/bus routes to Endcliffe Village from the railway station or coach station. Most of the buses which serve this destination stop on Fulwood Road at the junction with Endcliffe Crescent (see campus map). These include the 120 bus from Flat Street stop FS1 and the no. 6 bus from Arundel Gate stop AG11 (see city centre map). If you are planning to travel by bus it is advisable to research your journey via the links on the university website as close to your departure date as possible, as both the timetables and the location of bus stops in the city centre are liable to change.

Arriving at the Edcliffe Student Village

If you are resident at Jonas Hotel (or Halifax Hall Hotel) you may wish to go there first to collect your room key and deposit luggage. Then you can walk to The Edge (about 5 minutes) to register for the meeting at the SOTS registration desk. If you are non-resident please go straight to The Edge to register.
