


Directions for St Hilda's College, Oxford

SOTS Summer Meeting 21st – 24th July 2014



St. Hilda's College is easily accessible by road, train, or bus. Buses from London and the airports stop a short distance from the college as do park and ride buses and buses from the station.

If taking a bus from London or the London airports or from Thornhill Park & Ride, alight in St Clements, walk forward to the roundabout (the Plain), and Cowley Place (leading to St Hilda's College) is the third exit.

If taking a bus from the railway station, take no. 5 (for Blackbird Leys, from immediately outside the station building) to the bus stop just after The Plain; on alighting, walk back to the roundabout, and Cowley Place is the second exit.

For the more energetic it is 20-30 minute walk from the train station.

By car St Hilda's is best approached from the south (Iffley Rd A4158) or east London Rd (into St Clements). Those from the North and West are advised to take the ring road to either of these junctions unless they feel confident with the city centre one way systems.

Parking

As parking is very limited and expensive we highly recommend public transport.

St Hilda's has only 5 parking spaces which will be allocated to those most in need. Please apply on the booking form.

There is up to 72hrs parking (£12) at the Thornhill (bus 400) Park & Ride. Return tickets £2.70. Alight at St Clements (see above). There is equivalent 72hr parking at Water Eaton (bus 500) Park & Ride but a longer walk to St Hildas, and 7 day parking for £10 at Redbridge (bus 300) Park & Ride, alighting on St Aldates St. Check availability of spaces online at: http://www.oxford.gov.uk/PageRender/decTS/Park_and_Ride_occw.htm.

St Clements Car Park OX4 1AB is the closest Council car park, but has very few spaces. It is free, but only has 2hr parking.

Secure overnight car parking is available at Gloucester Green Car Park off Beaumont St, OX1 2BN, for £24.70 per 24 hours.
